No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days, subsequent to the opening of bids without the consent of the Bethlehem Housing Authority.

All City and State permits, as required, shall be obtained and paid for by the Contractor.

The lowest responsible bid will be selected by written resolution by the Board of Commissioners of the Bethlehem Housing Authority at a regularly scheduled Board meeting.
